ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & ENTRANCE EXAMINATION RULES

- **♣** Only female candidates may apply for M.Ed. programme.
- ← Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade in the B.Ed. or any equivalent Examination.
- Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD (Minimum disability 40%) will be as per Govt. rules. Relaxation of 5% marks will be admissible for SC/ST/PWD candidates as per Govt. rules.
- → Deputed teachers serving in substantive posts in Govt./Govt. sponsored/Govt. Aided Teachers' Training Institutions will be given preference. These candidates will be selected on the basis of length of continuous teaching experience.
- **↓** The ratio for **Home University** students and **Other University** students shall be **80:20**.

CALCULATION OF % OF MARKS

Percentage of marks will be calculated on the basis of marks printed in the Mark Sheet. If not available in the Mark Sheet, then it is to be calculated using CGPA to % Conversion rule of the concerned Board/University.

Entrance Examination:

- **M.Ed.** Entrance Examination fee: NIL
- ❖ Eligible Candidates have to appear at the Entrance Examination: Candidates who have passed /or appearing in the final Semester (in all papers) of the eligibility qualification (i.e. 4th Semester of B.Ed. Examination) are also allowed to appear at the Entrance Examination. However Provisional Admission will be offered with the aforementioned condition that she will clear the eligibility qualification with minimum 50% marks, failing which her
 - candidature will be cancelled.
- ❖ There will be a written test of 50 multiple choice questions (MCQ) with full marks 50 (each questions carrying 1 mark). Time for the test will be one hour with negative marks of 0.25 for each wrong answer. The questions will be mostly on Core Papers of B.Ed. curriculum of affiliating University (BSAEU).
- Deputed candidate need not to appear in the entrance examination.

NOTE: Candidates are to bring print out of their Application Form along with the original Mark sheet of B.Ed. Final Examination or Admit Card of their 4th Semester B.Ed. Examination and original Aadhar Card in the examination hall.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING

Merit-Listed candidates have to report physically with ID proof (AADHAAR) and

- 1. All original hard copies with self-attested photocopy of testimonials on 27th September, 2024 before 12 Noon at College Campus. (In case of submitted Original Documents through online mode, authentication of hard copies by the concerned authority is required.)
 - a) Mark sheet and certificate for all stages of examinations passed
 - b) Age proof document
 - c) University Registration Certificate
 - d) Certificate for Reserved Categories (SC, ST, PWD & updated OBC-NCL certificate for OBC-A & B).
 - e) 'No Objection Certificate' from College Authority (for Deputed Candidates only).

NOTE: Submission of OBC-NCL Certificate is mandatory as per norms.

- 2. One self-attested print-out of the filled-up Application Form.
- **3.** Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant.

SELECTION METHOD

- ♣ The merit list for admission will be prepared on the basis of scores of the Entrance Examination only.
- Applications will be verified by college from uploaded documents.
- Selection of Deputed candidates for admission will be made on the basis of Service Seniority.
- If the scores of multiple candidates become equal, the following method of academic score will be taken into consideration for the preparation of the merit list.




DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS AS PER AFFILIATING UNIVERSITY (BSAEU) [DISCIPLINE WISE]


