ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Only female candidates (both deputed & fresher) may apply for B. Ed. Programme.
- Atleast 50% marks either in Graduation or Master Degree OR, At least 55% marks in B.E./B.Tech. with specialization in Science and Mathematics OR, Other qualification equivalent thereto (Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PWD).

[As per NCTE Regulations, 2014 and Rules of the BSAEU (Erstwhile WBUTTEPA) and Department of Higher Education, Government of W.B.]

• Result published on or before 15.09.2025 i.e. the closing date of online form fill up will be considered only. Submission of partial or incomplete result will not be accepted (eg. A student cannot upload the result upto 3rd semester where the final examination result will be published after 4th semester). Submission of incomplete result will liable to be rejected.

CALCULATION OF % OF MARKS

Percentage of marks will be calculated on the basis of marks printed in the Mark Sheet. If not available in the Mark Sheet, then it is to be calculated using CGPA to % Conversion rule of the concerned Board/University.



ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION DETAILS (ON THE DATE OF APPLICATION)

- 1. For H.S. (under WBCHSE or CBSE class XII or ISC Class XII or equivalent level), % of marks of the best five subjects excluding Environment Science/Studies.
- 2. Honours Graduates have to enter the % of marks in the row of 'Honours Degree' **BUT** Pass/General Graduates have to enter the % of total marks in the '**B.A/B.Sc./Pass/General'** row only.
- 3. Honours Graduates having <50% in Honours but >= 50% in (Hons.+ Pass/General) will be considered as Pass/General (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and have to enter the % of marks in 'Pass/General' row only.
- 4. Master degree holders having < 50% in Honours but >= 50% in Master Degree are also eligible (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and they should enter the % of Honours marks in the row of 'Honours Degree'.
- 5. Candidates having **Integrated Master Degree** should enter % of Marks of first three years in the row of '**Honours Degree**' and last two years in the row of '**Master Degree**'.
- 6. Candidates having Master's degree in **Music** but **Honours in other subject** should enter % of Marks in Honours and Master's degree row.
- 7. Honours or Master Degree candidates who have not studied subjects offered by the college at Honours or Master Degree but studied it at Pass/General (see the List of offered Subjects) may apply as Pass/General. They should not enter % of marks in the 'Honours' or 'Master's Degree' row.
- 8. B.E./B.Tech. (or any other qualification equivalent thereto) candidates with Science and/or Mathematics, with 55% marks, have to enter the % of marks of B.E./B.Tech. in the row of Honours Degree (5% relaxation for SC/ST/PWD) and should not enter % of marks of M.E./M.Tech. (if any) in the 'Master's Degree' row.

SELECTION METHOD

- 1. Applications will be verified by College from uploaded documents.
- 2. Selection of Deputed candidates for admission will be made on Service Seniority.
- **3.** Selection of Fresher candidates will be made on Academic Scoring.

- **♣** Release order from the Headmaster / Headmistress.
- ♣ Attested copy of M.C. resolution with regards to her deputation, countersigned by D. I. of Schools (Secondary).
- Certificate from Concerned Authority whether the candidate teaches in Class VI or above.
- ♣ Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant.
- ♣ A certificate with the following information is to be submitted from the Secretary or Headmaster/Headmistress (where she is serving) and counter signed by the D.I. of Schools of the District concerned:
 - Certified that the School is in receipt of aid on full/ deficit/ lump sum grant basis or that school in unaided or salary deficit scheme one.
 - Certified that she is duly approved teacher.
 - Certified that she is being deputed by the school for undergoing two year B.Ed. Courses (2025-27).
- o Candidates pursuing any other course in the BSAEU or any other University during 2025-27 academic session are not eligible for admission to the B. Ed. programme for the session 2025-27.

- All stakeholders shall adhere to the Covid-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Government from time to time.
- ➤ All the selected candidates have to submit Anti-Ragging declaration in the prescribed format at the time of admission.
- For any modification/amendment, will be notified later.
